Training starts 4th June.

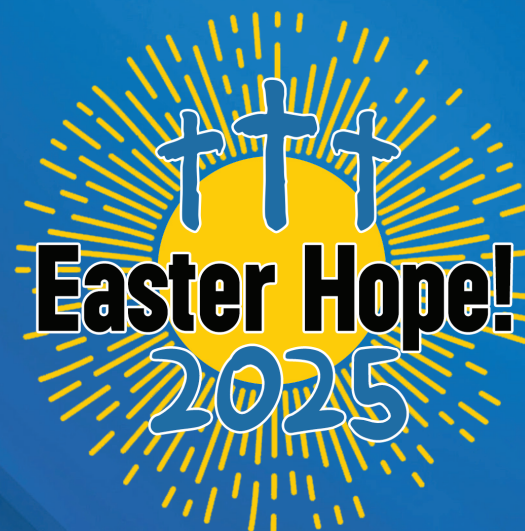
